

## **Cenac Marine History**

In 1927 the Cenac family got its start in the Oil business, when Ovide "Jock" Cenac began converting oyster schooners, then powered by sail, into new motorized vessels. Outfitted with Cummins diesel engines, the wooden barges were used for towing oil rigs and hauling crude oil for a company that would later become known as Texaco.

Over the next 56 years, Jock Cenac expanded the company's reach across the Gulf Coast. Arlen "Benny" Cenac Jr. took the helm of his grandfather's company, Cenac Towing Company in 1983.

## Throughout its history, Cenac holds title too many milestone developments in its field.

- Not only was Cenac the first company to install Cummins diesel engines on a marine vessel- they were also the first to institute the US Coast Guard tank barge self-inspection program, and with Coast Guard's approval, the first to institute its own tanker man training program.
- Cenac was the first to perform well test and flow back operations in the Gulf of Mexico. As part of Conoco's Magnolia project, they were the first company to moor a liquid petroleum barge to a dynamic positioning drilling rig in the Gulf.
- Cenac Towing has entrenched itself as a leader in the towing and tank barge industry, drawing upon nearly a century's worth of expertise and industry

- knowledge. Their safety record is impeccable- ranking them in the top echelon of towing companies that work with major oil companies and refiners.
